4	GROSS DESCRIPTION: Received in formalin, labeled "XX", " left lobe of thyroid ", is a 50-gram thyroid gland which is received in nine separate fragments which vary from 2-6 cm. The majority of the largest fragment is encapsulated and this surface is inked. The largest specimen consists of a partially hemorrhagic, circumscribed, tan-red, focally disrupted nodule 4.5 x 3.5 x 6 cm. The additional smaller fragments are detached pieces from this large nodule. Representative material is submitted in A1-A7.
